

## Competitions 2021-22

### **Ayala Shield** - October 6<sup>th</sup>, December 1<sup>st</sup> & March 2<sup>nd</sup>

Three categories: Colour Prints, Mono Prints & PDI's. Images cannot have been used previously in the Ayala competition.

These competitions will be judged by an external judge.

### **Rainbow Trophy and Jubilee Trophy** - November 17<sup>th</sup>

The Rainbow Trophy is a set subject PDI competition, the subject is 'Colours' and the images can be either colour or mono. Two entries per member.

The Jubilee Trophy is a set subject print competition, the subject is 'Gates' (gateways will also be acceptable).

Two categories: Colour Prints and Mono Prints. Members can enter 2 prints in each category.

These competitions will be judged by members. Images entered cannot have been used previously either competition.

### **Versatile Photographer Trophy** - January 19<sup>th</sup>

This is a print competition. Members must enter one mono or colour print per theme in all four rounds, which are: Photojournalism, Panorama, Abstract and Low Lighting.

This competition will be judged by an external judge. Images cannot have been used previously this competition.

### **Anniversary Trophy** - May 4<sup>th</sup>

There are three categories in this competition: Colour Prints, Mono Prints & PDI's

This competition will be judged by members.

Entries must be a print that has been used in competition during the current season.

Images entered cannot have been used previously in the Anniversary Trophy competition.

### **Print and Mount Sizes**

Unless specified otherwise prints can be of any size but must be mounted:

- Maximum size of mount is 50.8cm x 40.64cm (20" x 16")
- Minimum size of mount is 25.4cm x 20.32cm (10" x 8")

### **PDIs**

• Images must be captured by either digital camera or digital scanning from negative, slide or print. Images that are computer generated are not permitted.

• Total images (including any borders, etc.) must be in jpeg format at maximum quality and no more than 1400 pixels wide by 1050 pixels high. If in portrait format the maximum height will be 1050 pixels.

• The title of your image will be displayed for a short time when your image is first projected. Therefore, please capitalise and put spacing between words as required, for example:

The **Darling Buds of May**

**Abstract in Green**

Please check for spelling or typing errors. What you type will be projected as your image title. Very long titles may be truncated. The software knows to ignore the sequence number when showing the title in a competition.
